

Safeguarding Children Statement of Commitment

St Michael's Collegiate School is committed to safeguarding students and children in its care. As part of this commitment, we have developed Safeguarding Practices and Behaviour Guidelines for our School, and these are approved and endorsed by our School Board.

All our 'involved' personnel, from our Board members, Principal and senior managers to casual employees and volunteers, are required to observe our Code of Conduct, Safeguarding Students and Children Policy, Safeguarding Practices and Behaviours Guidelines and Policy and Mandatory Reporting Policy.

The School considers a failure to observe our guidelines to be misconduct and will result in appropriate disciplinary action. Depending on the seriousness of the misconduct, disciplinary action may include suspension while matters are investigated and/or dismissal. In addition to any internal disciplinary proceedings, any breaches of law will be reported to police.
